

## 6. Keeping the Community in Childcare

Nightcliff Family Centre is a community-based childcare Centre. This means it is not a profitdriven operation. The Centre is concerned with providing the best possible care for our children at a very reasonable rate. To balance those conflicting goals, we rely on active parental involvement in assisting with the management of the Centre.

Aside from our annual membership fee (\$50p.a), your involvement in our Centre is needed to help with keeping our Centre operating at its very best.

Being a member of the NFC Management Committee, getting involved in our fundraising efforts or helping with our working bees are active ways in which you can contribute.

The option of placing your child in the care of our non-commercial Centre can only continue with parental involvement.

If there is no Management Committee, there is no childcare Centre.

Management Committee meetings are held monthly, in the early evening, 2-hour duration.

Working bees and fundraising activities are held quarterly.
